

Secure robust financial assistance to relieve renters' past due rent & restore lost revenue for housing providers.

End the use of federal eviction moratoriums & address moratorium impacts.

Enacting liability protections.

#### The American Rescue Plan

American Rescue plan includes \$40 billion in essential housing & homelessness assistance funding, including:



\$25+ billion in dedicated rental assistance



\$1,400 in direct stimulus checks, although the upper income limit per individual was reduced to \$80,000 from \$100,000



An increase in unemployment benefits to \$400 per week & an extension of enhanced benefits through August



\$5 billion for homeless prevention
